Spirit of God, breathing in me Spirit of God, we thank you.


Father, Son and Spirit, in sky, land, in room, in seat in breath and beat Your presence everywhere

Come as you are


You see through me My self is glass to you You have made me Know every cell of me You get why I do what I do, why I say what I say. And I do not need to.
